

March - June / September - December







### **INTERNATIONAL SEMESTER**

The International Semester at DHBW Villingen-Schwenningen takes place twice a year from the end of March to June and from the end of September to December. Both semesters are taught in English.

The International Semester starts with a two-day introduction to academic life in Germany.

Students are consulted individually on their course selection. The semester is designed to challenge and inspire an international mix of students at a university known for its dual system of higher education and close relations with employers.

Studies in Villingen-Schwenningen include cultural and social activities as part of the experience through company visits and excursions to the beautiful Black Forest region and beyond.

#### **COURSES**

Students from partner universities can choose from a variety of lectures, workshops and seminars, all of which are taught in English and have a highly interactive approach. Every international semester comprises different modules taught in English, as well as language classes, e.g. German, French, Spanish. Many courses involve innovative learning methods such as Blended Learning.

The courses available cover a wide range of subjects, from Cross-Cultural Competence to International Logistics, Marketing Management and language classes. They all give students the opportunity to interact with people from a variety of backgrounds while experiencing academic life in Germany.

#### **CREDITS**

All courses earn credits. Assessment may take different forms, e.g. written exams or project assignments. Students are awarded a certificate and a transcript of grades at the end of the International Semester.

#### REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must come from our partner universities abroad and have a minimum English language proficiency of B1.

#### COSTS

Students are responsible for their own living expenses, e.g. accommodation, transportation.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

The DHBW Villingen-Schwenningen will help the students to find appropriate accommodation.
